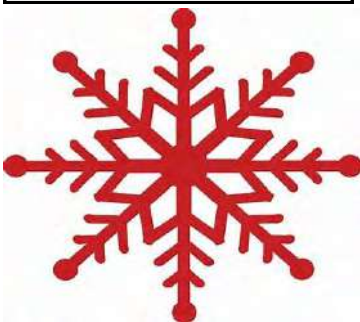

The HOA Financial Summary for November shows revenue of \$38,390, reflecting a positive variance to budget of \$48. Expenses of \$34,086 were under budget by \$2,092 related primarily to savings in payroll of \$1,823. The net operating shows a positive variance of \$2,140. Year to date total net operating is \$15,107 over budget. Total Cash on Hand is \$210,652 and the Capital Funds Balance is \$133,559 including reserves. Both are strong for the HOA.

In November, total revenue of \$254,823 was over budget by \$2,691. This is primarily related to an increase in interest revenue of \$3,010. Total expenses for the month came in at \$241,636, which is \$6,107 over budget. This is related to the timing of chemical expense of \$4,500, Electric expense of \$1,800 for two months of billing for the pumphouse. Our net P/L came in under budget by \$5,540 for the month. Year to date net P/L is at \$81,912, which reflects a positive variance to the budget of \$38,762. Total Operating Cash on Hand is good at \$274,236 and capital funds are strong at \$1,015,823. Emerald Bay is financially sound.

- **MOTION TO APPROVE SENDING PROPOSED HOA BYLAW AMENDMENTS REGARDING FINE SCHEDULE TO THE MEMBERSHIP FOR A VOTE**

**NAN STEGEMOELLER**

I move that we approve the proposed amendments regarding Fine Schedule to be sent to the Membership for a vote.

ARTICLE 4 - GOVERNMENT AND GENERAL MANAGEMENT, Paragraph 4.5 (ii) is amended as follows:

**(ii) Fixing and imposing penalties for the violations of the Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, and Restrictions and Covenants, in accordance with Article 8.5 of the Bylaws hereinbelow, and the HOA Fine and Enforcement Policy.**

ARTICLE 8 – GENERAL PROVISIONS is amended by adding the following Paragraph 8.5:

**8.5 SCHEDULE OF FINES. In accordance with the terms of Article B, Section 23 of the Modification of Restrictive Covenants of Emerald Bay Subdivision, as Amended, the following Schedule of Fines is hereby incorporated into these By-Laws:**

**8.5.1 Non-curable violations:****i) Speeding violation - 1st offense****In Excess of posted limit:**

<b>1 - 5 MPH</b>	<b>\$50</b>
<b>6 - 10 MPH</b>	<b>\$100</b>
<b>11 - 15 MPH</b>	<b>\$150</b>
<b>16 - 20 MPH</b>	<b>\$175</b>
<b>21+ MPH</b>	<b>\$200</b>

**ii) Speeding violation – 2nd offense****In Excess of posted limit:**

<b>1 - 5 MPH</b>	<b>\$125</b>
<b>6 - 10 MPH</b>	<b>\$150</b>
<b>11 - 15 MPH</b>	<b>\$175</b>
<b>16 - 20 MPH</b>	<b>\$200</b>
<b>21+ MPH</b>	<b>\$225</b>

**iii) Speeding violation – 3rd and subsequent offenses****In Excess of posted limit:**

<b>1 - 5 MPH</b>	<b>\$175</b>
<b>6 - 10 MPH</b>	<b>\$200</b>
<b>11 - 15 MPH</b>	<b>\$225</b>
<b>16 - 20 MPH</b>	<b>\$250</b>
<b>21+ MPH</b>	<b>\$275</b>

**iv) Passing a school bus, whether stopped or moving:**



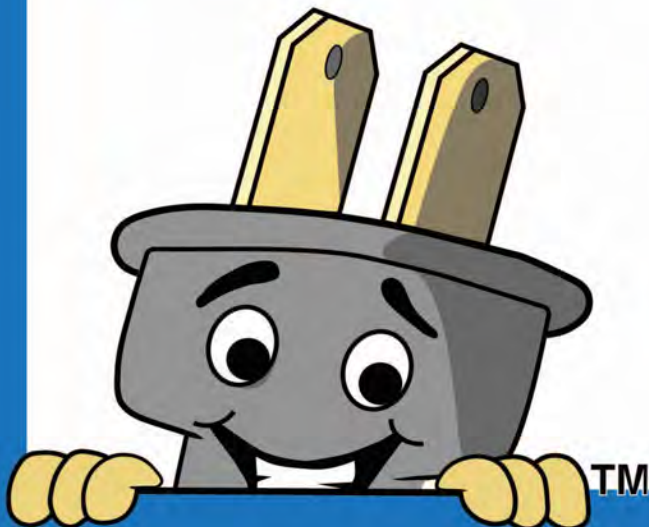

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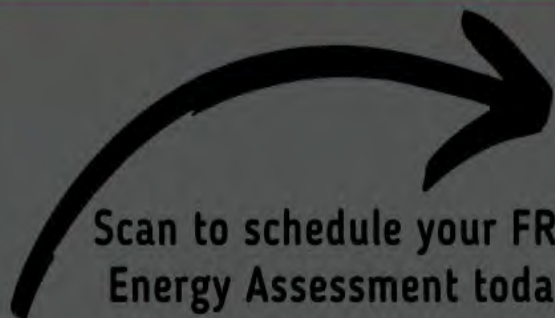
